

## Create a copy of an existing vdv entity

1. Run the spContextMenuCopy.sql script in Query Analyzer to create the stored procedure
2. Create a new view in SQL Server using the existing vdv view as your base
3. Save the new view with the same vdv name with \_RKL at the end
4. Go into MAS500 Task Editor and create a new task for the vdv

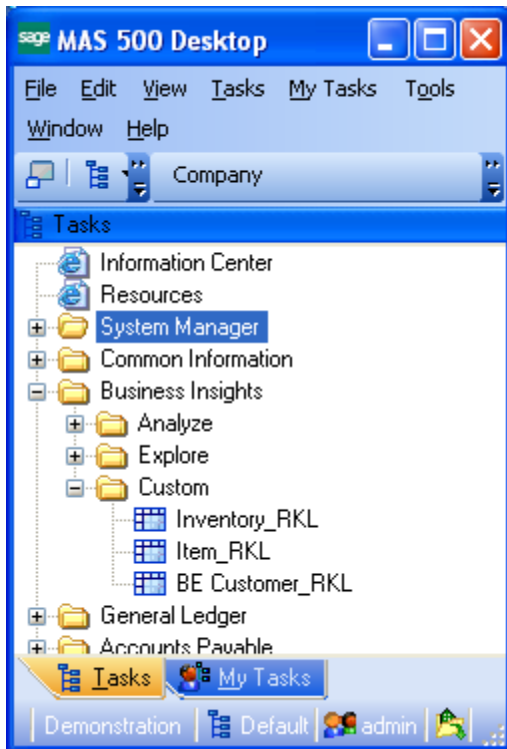

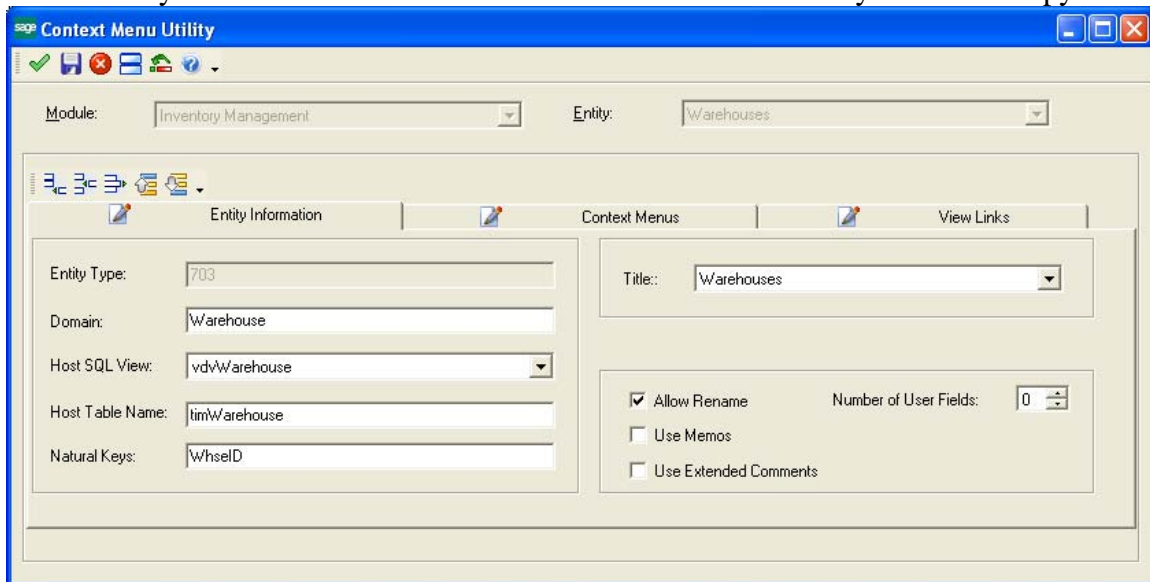

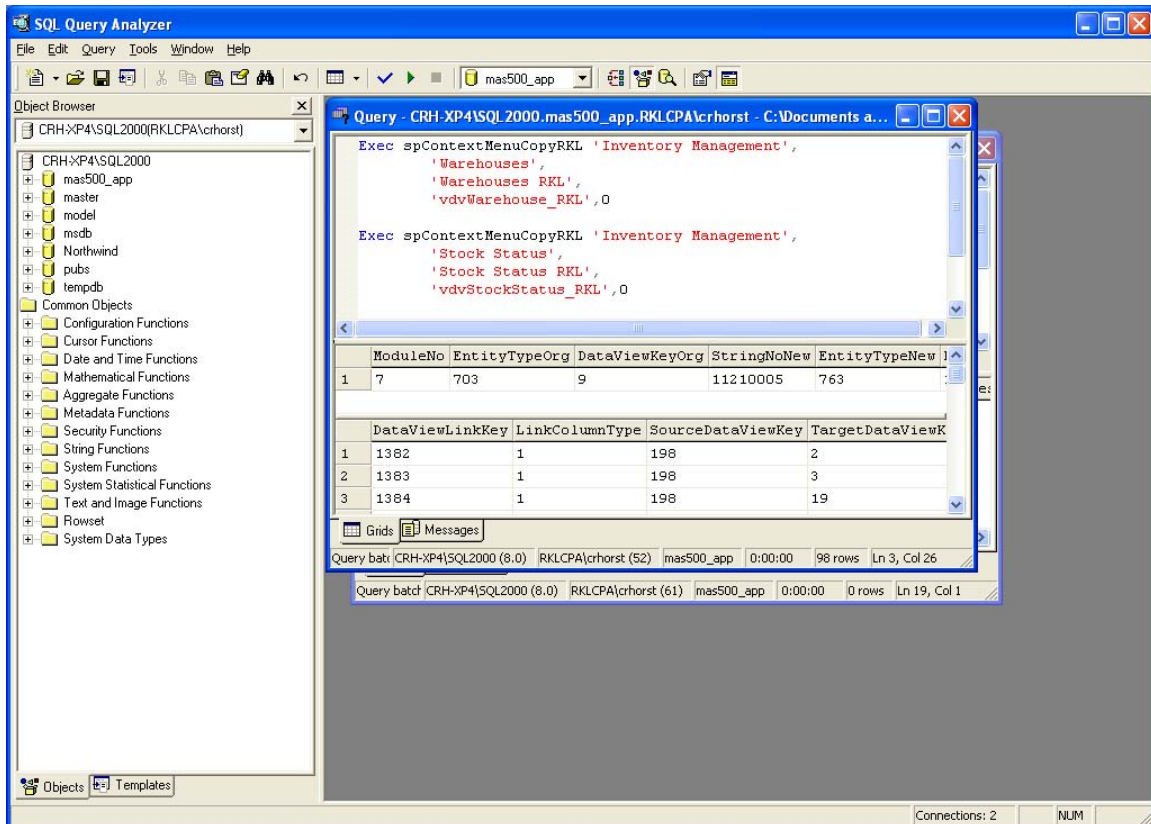
5. Place it in the Custom Business Insights folder



6. Save your changes to the MAS500 menu
7. Launch the context menu utility and find the module name, old entity name, new entity name and a 0 for create or 1 for rollback for the vdv you wish to copy



8. Create the following query and execute it to create the new vdv settings Exec spContextMenuCopyRKL 'Inventory Management', 'Warehouses', 'Warehouses RKL', 'vdvWarehouse\_RKL',0
9. If you are not satisfied with the results, create the following query and execute it to remove the new vdv settings Exec spContextMenuCopyRKL 'Inventory Management', 'Warehouses', 'Warehouses RKL', 'vdvWarehouse\_RKL',1



10. Launch the new explorer window from MAS500 to verify it is working correctly and drilling to the other windows
11. Open the new vdv in the context menu utility to verify the links were copied correctly
